CycleTel™ is our mHealth innovation, developed and tested in India, that is positioned to be the first ever family planning method offered via SMS. No doctors, no visits to the health clinic—CycleTel puts family planning knowledge and use in the hands of couples, on their mobile devices. Based on the Standard Days Method® (SDM) of family planning, our service has the potential to reach millions of women in India who have access to a mobile phone.

CycleTel seeks a Technology Manager to play a leadership role in leading all aspects of CycleTel's technical vision and product development. The candidate will have an exceptional track record in leading teams, designing, developing and scaling new products/services in India with at least 5+ years of software product leadership, ideally with mobile.

CycleTel is an initiative developed and incubated by Georgetown University's Institute for Reproductive Health in Washington, DC. IRH works to reduce unmet need for family planning by increasing fertility awareness and expanding access to family planning methods.

POSITION SUMMARY

The Technology Manager will assume overall responsibilities for developing, improving, monitoring, and troubleshooting the technical system for CycleTel in India and worldwide. The Technology Manager will be responsible for the evolution and enhancement of the CycleTel application to enable successful scale up and work with IRH business stakeholders in India, US and other countries to realize the vision of the CycleTel service and guide its evolution. The Technical Manager will provide integration and support for database management software, assist research team in understanding product performance and consumer trends, support CycleTel's product expansion to additional countries, and participate in the development and integration of CycleTel application with technical partners. The Technical Manager will be part of the CycleTel team in India, and work in close partnership with the two Managing Directors of CycleTel, based in Washington DC and India.

- **Manage technical strategy and implementation plan, including identifying areas of improvement and managing technological scale up as CycleTel grows towards over 150,000 users**
 - Manage negotiation and integration with technology partners including SMS gateways, telecom rentals, hardware systems, software vendors and payment partners.
 - Manage end-to-end process and relationships, beginning with initial feasibility assessments and continuing through ongoing operational support
 - Supervise a junior and be responsible for setting development and coding brief for others
 - Work with a cross-functional team to consistently deliver high-quality end-user experiences
 - Lead market research and competitor analysis for other technology products in the mHealth field, especially as related to reproductive health and pregnancy planning.
- **Develop, maintain and expand the CycleTel product offering in India and worldwide, ensuring that CycleTel remains a high quality and reliable service**
 - Develop the CycleTel product with focus on improving user interface and adding customer engagement features
 - Be responsible for deployment and rolling out the application to support CycleTel's expansion to additional countries
