WHAT IS UNIQUE ABOUT EARLY ADOLESCENCE?

- ✓ Critical time of rapid physical, neurological, emotional and social development and transitions
- ✓ Period where lifelong attitudes and behaviors are formed
- ✓ Increased influence of gender inequities on health and educational, economic opportunities
- Limited access to quality information and services

THE SEEDS OF FUTURE WELL-BEING ARE SOWN IN EARLY ADOLESCENCE

- ✓ Smoking, alcohol use and unhealthy diet
- ✓ School absenteeism and drop out
- Exposure to physical, emotional and sexual violence
- ✓ Sexual debut and risky sexual behaviors (HIV, pregnancy)
- ✓ Early marriage
- ✓ Mental health



WHAT DOES REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH HAVE TO DO WITH 10-14 YEAR OLDS?

BEFORE THE AGE OF 15, IN SOME COUNTRIES AS MANY AS...

- One-third of girls have had sex
- One quarter of girls are married

GLOBALLY....

- 2 million girls give birth every year
- One-third of births are unplanned
- 20% reporting sexual violence said it first occurred in early adolescence
- 85% of boys and girls report violent discipline in the previous month
