NFP Teachers completing the Standard Days Method (SDM) Webinar Course, and who are interested in receiving a certificate of completion must complete the practical training portion of the course. Course participants have two practicum options: (1) either provide the method to a couple interested in using SDM or; (2) offer an information session to a group of potential users interested in an NFP method. Following are instructions for completing either one of the practicum options to apply for a certificate of completion of the full Webinar Course.

PRACTICUM OPTION 2: Group information session

The purpose of this activity is to practice describing to a group of women, couples or colleagues how the method works, and where to find more information.

Preparing to teach the method to a group

- Review the lesson plan for the session and prepare the materials needed.
- Review the tips for offering clear information included in the lesson plan, especially if this is your first time conducting a group activity.
- Have the materials you need for the session ready as well as those to distribute to participants.
- Schedule the session and invite participants. You also have the option of completing a practice simulation session with friends and family. This session will also count for the certificate of course completion.
